Introduction

The BG-8K-DA18 is a high-performance 1x8 HDMI splitter that distributes a single HDMI source to up to eight displays simultaneously, delivering uncompromised video and audio quality. Supporting resolutions up to 8K@60Hz (4:2:0 12-bit) and 4K@120Hz (4:4:4 12-bit), it is fully compliant with HDMI 2.1 and HDCP 2.3 standards for seamless compatibility with devices like the Xbox Series X and PlayStation 5. The splitter supports both FRL (48Gbps) and TMDS (18Gbps) bandwidths, along with key HDMI 2.1 features including VRR, ALLM, QMS, QFT, and SBTM for a dynamic and responsive viewing experience. HDR formats such as HDR10, HDR10+, Dolby Vision, and HLG are also fully supported.

Designed for flexibility, each output offers auto downscaling and HDR-to-SDR conversion, making it easy to mix new and legacy displays. The BG-8K-DA18 ensures rich, immersive audio with support for LPCM 7.1, Dolby TrueHD, Dolby Atmos, and DTS-HD Master Audio. Advanced EDID management and built-in cable equalization streamline installation and maintain optimal signal performance in demanding AV environments.

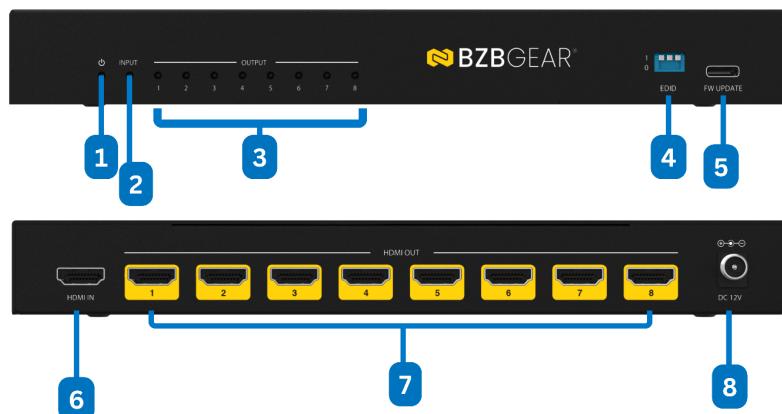

Operation Controls and Functions

Front and Rear Panel

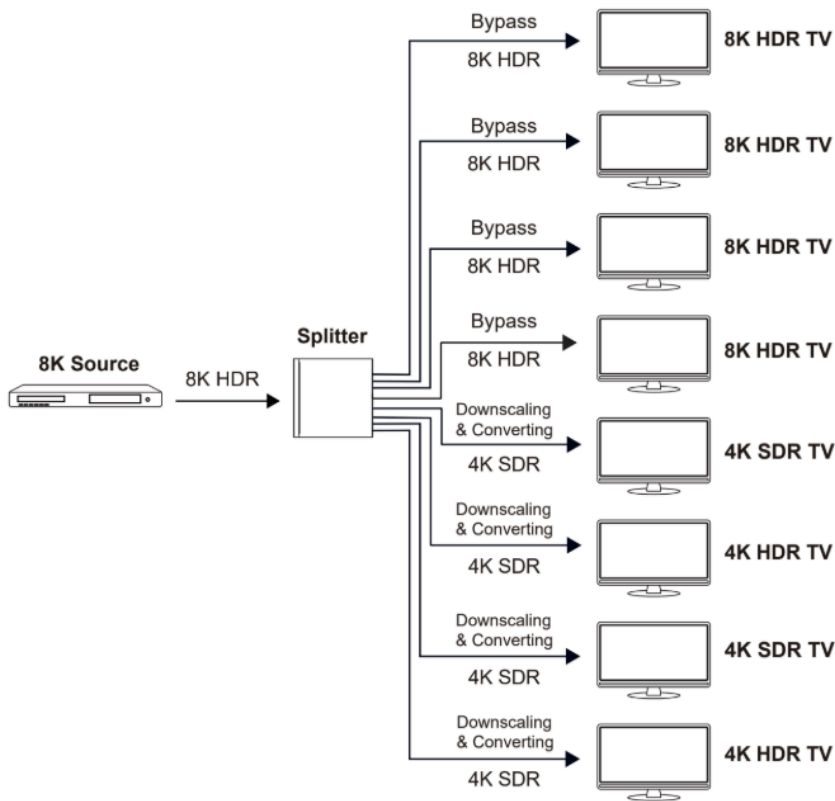


No.	Name	Function Description
1	POWER LED	When the device is powered on, the red LED will be on.
2	IN LED	When the HDMI IN port connects to an active source device, the green LED will be on.
3	OUT LED (1~8)	When the HDMI OUT 1/2/3/4/5/6/7/8 port connects to a display device and outputs signal, the corresponding green LED will be on.
4	EDID DIP switch	Use the DIP switch to set EDID: - [DIP]=111: Copy OUT port sink EDID (Factory default) - [DIP]=110: 4K60(4:4:4), 2.0CH - [DIP]=101: FRL12G_8K_HDR, 2.0CH - [DIP]=100: FRL12G_8K_HDR, 5.1CH - [DIP]=011: FRL12G_8K_HDR, 7.1CH - [DIP]=010: FRL10G_8K_HDR, 2.0CH - [DIP]=001: FRL10G_8K_HDR, 5.1CH - [DIP]=000: FRL10G_8K_HDR, 7.1CH
5	SERVICE	Firmware update port.
6	IN port	HDMI signal input port, connecting to an HDMI source device such as DVD player or PS5 with an HDMI cable.
7	OUT port (1~8)	HDMI signal output ports, connecting to HDMI display devices such as TVs or monitors with HDMI cables.
8	DC 12V	12V/2.5A power input port.

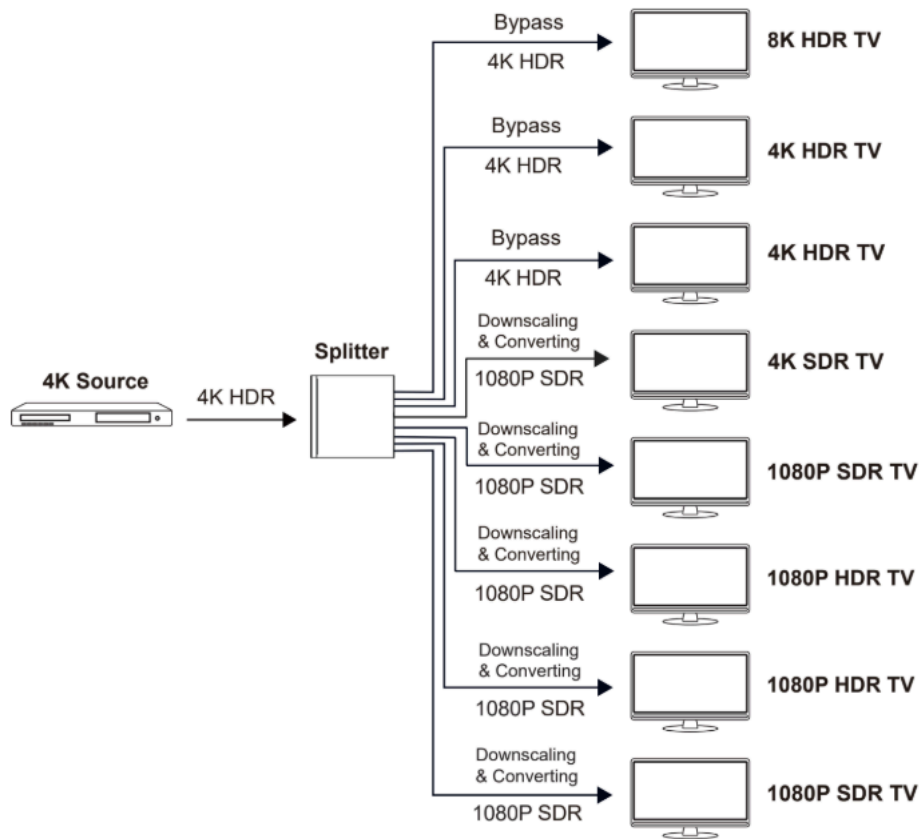


Auto Downscaling & Format Conversion

The 48Gbps 1x8 HDMI splitter features automatic downscaling and format conversion on all outputs, ensuring optimal compatibility with connected display devices. It intelligently reads the EDID information from each display and determines the appropriate output signal. Before applying downscaling, the splitter compares the EDID data from all connected displays and selects the lowest supported resolution as the output baseline. This ensures that every display receives a compatible signal without manual configuration. For example:



In the example above, since 4K is lower than the resolution of the input source, the splitter will automatically downscale the signal and output it at the minimum supported resolution of 4K SDR.



Note: If the source signal is downscaled and converted to 1080p DVI based on the EDID of connected display devices, the output will not include audio, as DVI does not carry sound.

In the example above, since 1080p is lower than the input resolution, the splitter will automatically downscale the signal and output it at the minimum supported resolution of 1080p SDR.

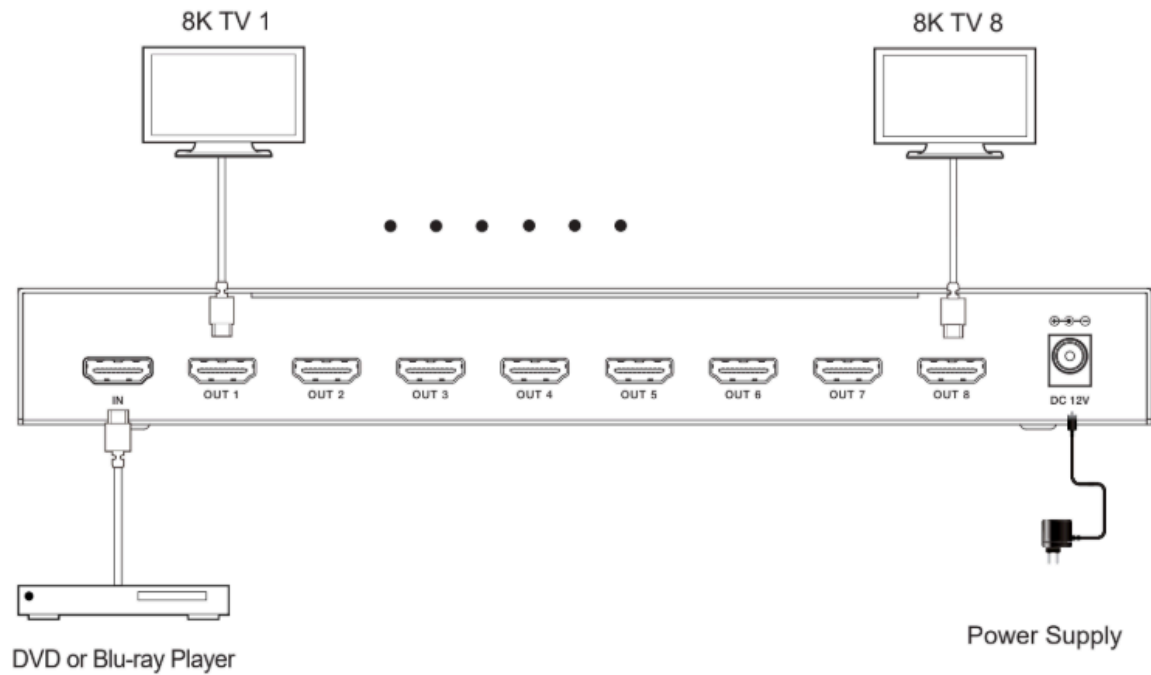
Limitations of Downscaling:

Downscaling will not function under the following conditions:

1. The input source is using the 8K DSC (Display Stream Compression) format.
2. The input resolution is not supported by the splitter.

Troubleshooting

Problems	Causes	Solutions
No Power / All LED off	Power supply not connected, connected fully, or wrong power supply.	Check if the power supply is connected correctly and the output voltage value is within recommended specifications.
No sound or sound issues	The HDMI connection is faulty, the audio format is not supported by the displays, or the source player is set to another port for audio output	Check if the HDMI cables are connected correctly. Check if the audio format is supported by the display and that a user has not changed the supported audio format on the player's audio output. Ensure output settings from the HDMI source device as set correctly.
No picture or picture flickers	The HDMI cable may be faulty or the category cable quality is faulty.	Check if the HDMI and category cable connections are correct and undamaged. Change to another good working HDMI cable or category cable (CAT6 or better cable is recommended).
