


Figure 1.1 Product Interfaces













2.) Ceiling Mounting






1.) RS-232 Interface Description






WebGUI

The BG-ND camera includes a built-in WebGUI allowing for control and management of advanced features. Use the following instructions to access the WebGUI.

- 1. Launch a web browser and enter the IP address of the unit (default 192.168.5.163).
- 2. The BZBGEAR login page will appear.
- 3. Enter your login information (by default **Username** = admin **Password** = admin).
- 4. Select the Login button.

My camera has no picture	Power is off, bad connection, incompatible resolution, camera lens is obstructed	 Check the power connection on the back of the camera Check connections/replace cables with new ones Use IR remote or WebGUI to change to a resolution that is compatible with your display Check computer and program settings to ensure USB is discovered
My IR remote control doesn't work	The camera's IR sensor is blocked, batteries are dead, sunlight is interfering with the IR signal	 Ensure you have a clear line of sight from the remote to the front of the camera base Replace the batteries Ensure the camera is out of direct sunlight
I cannot access the camera's WebGUI	The camera is not connected to the network	 Check connections Verify your camera's IP address using an IP scanning tool Ensure your computer is connected to the same network as the camera
I have no image from my USB connection	Your USB device is not being discovered	 Make sure you're using a USB 3.0 cable Try a different USB 3.0 cable (6 feet or less) Try a different USB port on your computer or a different computer
